

9373 Terms of the G. Parsonage glebe land of Goodbyne, in the Parishes  
 afore sd: taken by the devise & confirmation of Jo: M. Deale, & James  
 Baber, (Churchwardens) & others the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June: 1625.

Item: the G. Parsonage house & the homestead containing by estimation 3 roodes  
 and within the sd house there are best rooms (viz:) a hall furnished w<sup>th</sup>  
 one plow, a sculling house, and w<sup>th</sup> entering all becombed w<sup>th</sup>  
 a kitchen & a buttry.  
 And in the yard are best buildings (viz:) a stable, and one bay of husbandry  
 And one hay barn containing 2 bays, & 2 other barns cont<sup>g</sup> 4 bays  
 And one orchard & garden p<sup>ts</sup> of the homestead cont<sup>g</sup> 1 rood

Item: 2 landes on Lammoale, w<sup>ch</sup> the grass at the ends, Jo: Howitt East &  
 T. Jo: Cleme West & are by estimation 1 rood & 1/2

And 3 landes more in the same furlong, Jo: Throok West, & T. Jo: Cleme  
 East, buttry North & South. Cont<sup>g</sup> 1 rood & 1/2

And 3 landes w<sup>ch</sup> the Mill gate having a balke on the East, & William Egippie  
 West, butt as before cont<sup>g</sup> 3 roodes

And 4 landes w<sup>ch</sup> the same way, Jo: William North, & William Egippie  
 South, butt East & West, cont<sup>g</sup> 3 roodes

And 2 landes in Long Stone, William M. Dillinson South, & Jo: Throok W.  
 butt East & West cont<sup>g</sup> 1 rood

And 3 landes in Stone Stone having a balke North, & Jo: Throok South  
 butt as before, cont<sup>g</sup> 3 roodes

And one land one land next to the sd 3 landes, the sand balke South, and a  
 land of T. Jo: Jaup North butt as before cont<sup>g</sup> with the end 2 roodes.

And another land in the same furlong, Jo: William South, & a balke North  
 about as before cont<sup>g</sup> 2 roodes.

And 2 little landes called Gales w<sup>ch</sup> a balke out of East, & William  
 Egippie West, w<sup>ch</sup> the grass ended cont<sup>g</sup> 1 rood

And 2 landes layed out on the Mill banks Jo: Throok North, butt East  
 & West, cont<sup>g</sup> with the grass ended 3 roodes

And 2 landes more in the same furlong, Jo: Throok North and  
 a balke South about as before, cont<sup>g</sup> with the end 3 roodes.

And 3 landes more layed out in the same furlong a balke on the South  
 & T. Jo: Jaup North, about as before cont<sup>g</sup> 1 rood, & 1/2



To the Glange furd: 2 landes & a balke betwene longhym on M. Dinga side fa. Marke  
 field. East, & to: faue M. east, abutt furd, & Marke, roud w<sup>th</sup> fonde, 2 2 roddes  
 Orable. And 4 landes longhym in y<sup>e</sup> same furlong, & to: Colome East, &  
 Dulse: Dulse M. east, roud w<sup>th</sup> y<sup>e</sup> grass end, 2 1 arve.  
 And one litle land buling into M. Dinga Dale, the linge maid M. east, &  
 Valentine Colome East, roud w<sup>th</sup> y<sup>e</sup> grass end, 2 1 rodd.  
 And 2 landes on y<sup>e</sup> greene gate, the linge way Marke, & to: Comaby  
 furd furd, abutt East, & M. east, & roud w<sup>th</sup> y<sup>e</sup> grass end 2 2 roddes.  
 And 4 landes in y<sup>e</sup> same furlong & to: Rose furd, and  
 to: Dulse Marke, abutt as before bond 2 1 arve.  
 And 12 landes longhym in y<sup>e</sup> middle furlong lying betwene  
 2 balke furd, & Marke, & abutting as before, roud 2 4 arves.  
 And 12 landes longhym more lying in the furlong next  
 belowe the 12 landes, balke on both sides, abutt as before 3 arves.

grass ground: furd: 3 layes on Orable layes a gadley of Dulse: Bealch  
 furd Marke, & a gadley of Dulse: Rose Duganye furd. 3 3 roddes  
 And 2 layes & a balke more in y<sup>e</sup> same furlong, & to: faue  
 Marke, & y<sup>e</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> ley of Dulse: Dulse furd, abutt as before, roud 2 2 roddes.  
 And 4 layes on y<sup>e</sup> M. Duganye layes, the Comon ground  
 more on y<sup>e</sup> bulke stand, on y<sup>e</sup> East, & a ley of M. Dulse x x  
 Wilkinson, <sup>more</sup> East, abutt Marke, & furd, bond 2 3 roddes.
